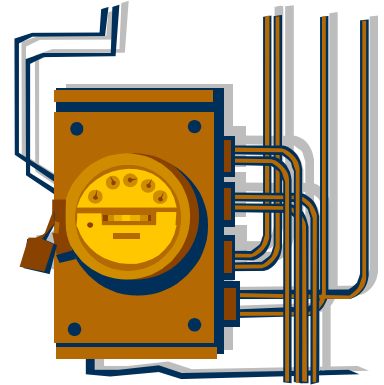
Matt Bullis is a Professional Engineer and has been our Madera Public Works Operations Director since 2007.

Today Matt is going to update us on water conservation programs and water meter regulations.



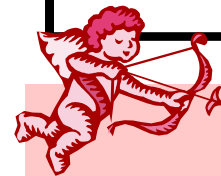
