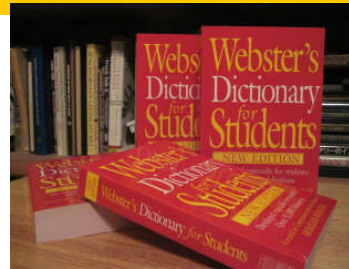
MIKE’S
